

Fitness Spotlight – Hydration

Our Fitness Spotlight for June will be on hydration! The adult human body is about 60 percent water and our blood, about 90 percent water. Every time we end doorway exercise, you are encouraged to take deep breaths in your apartment without your mask and to drink a glass of water. - Protects your tissues, and cushions spinal cord, brain and joints

- Helps transport oxygen in the cells


